Sunday 24 – Friday 29

9am – 9pm

- films and TV lounges.

Getting here

Minibuses to our day centres collect guests from pick-up points around London (see maps).

Pick-up times (from point one on each route):

23 December

First pick-up 11am.

Last pick-up 3pm.

24 – 29 December

First pick-up 9am.

Last pick-up 12noon.

You should not have to wait more than an hour for a bus. Please make your own way to the centre if you can.

Can I sleep at Crisis at Christmas?



Most of our guests (around 70 per cent) do not stay overnight. If you do not have anywhere to sleep please speak to a team leader at a day centre. We have some residential centres for people in the most urgent need.


Our day centres and how to find them




1. North London Day Centre
Westminster Kingsway College, 211 Gray's Inn Road WC1X 8RA

Pick-up route:

- 1. Outside Finsbury Park Station
- 2. Outside Kentish Town Jobcentre Plus



2. West London Day Centre
'(Guest entrance on Donnington Road)'
Capital City Academy, Doyle Gardens NW10 3ST

Pick-up route:

- 1. Victoria Station, near statue in Grosvenor Gardens
- 2. Chelsea Methodist Church, King's Road
- 3. Kensington Aldridge Academy (former West London Day Centre), Silchester Road



3. South London Day Centre
City of London Academy, Lynton Road SE1 5LA

Pick-up route:

- 1. Corner of Jebb Avenue and Brixton Hill – near Brixton Prison
- 2. Near Waterloo Station – The park on the corner of Waterloo Road and Baylis Road



4. East London Day Centre
The City Academy, Homerton Row, Hackney E9 6EA

Pick-up route:

- 1. Outside Stratford Picture House
- 2. Christ Church, Spitalfields (opposite Spitalfields Market)
