How do I get there?

Minibuses to our day centres collect guests from pick-up points around London (see maps).

Pick-up times
(from point 1 on each route):

23 December

First pick - up 11am

Last pick - up 3pm

24 - 29 December

First pick - up 9am

Last pick - up 12noon

You should not have to wait more than an hour for a bus. Please make your own way to the centre if you can.

Can I sleep at Crisis at Christmas?

Most of our guests do not stay overnight. If you do not have anywhere to sleep please speak to a team leader at a day centre. We have some residential centres for people in the most urgent need.

The centres are open 11am-9pm Sunday 23 December,
and 9am-9pm Monday 24 - Saturday 29 December.

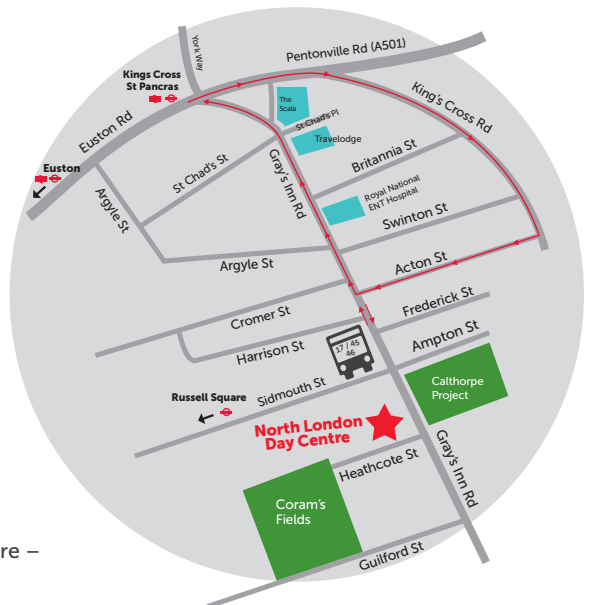


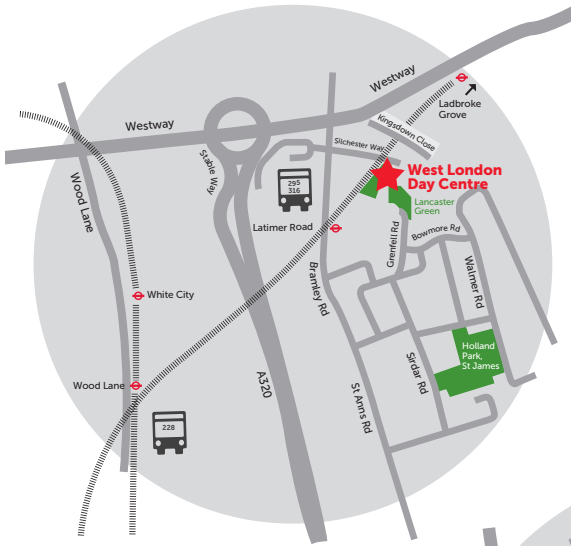

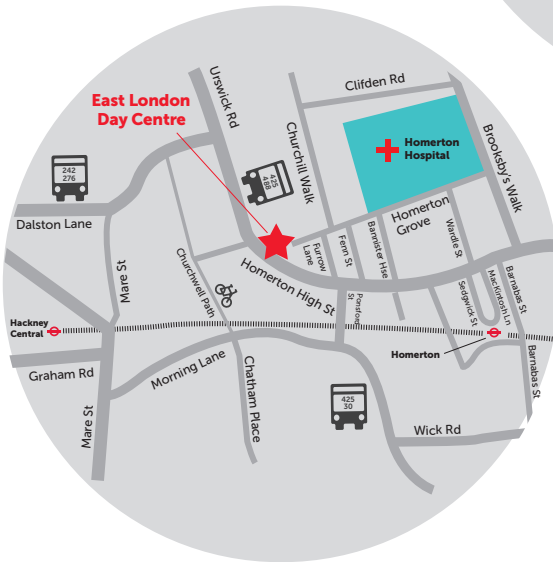
