



- Funding → Crowdfunding helps overcome the financial barriers
- Support → Beam caseworkers provide really personalised 1:1 support. Messages from the public also keep people motivated!

Beam empowers people affected or at risk of homelessness to improve their life

We can't do what we do, without you! Housing officers tell people who are currently, or at risk of, homelessness about Beam's service.


Referrals are made via a short online form: beam.org/refer



Caseworker matched

Based on your referral notes, a Beam caseworker is matched with the person referred. Together, they create a career plan and crowdfunding budget, personalised to their strengths and goals.

Beam uses the power of community crowdfunding and personalised one-to-one support



Goal crowdfunded

Beam fundraises costs required to remove financial barriers. This can include items to improve digital access (laptop, smartphone, wifi), training courses, childcare, travel, work attire etc. 100% of campaigns fund!

Work started <u>& sustained</u>

People referred receive Beam's personalised job support. We have 80+ employer partners and match people with local roles, plus help with CV's and interview preparation

Ongoing support is provided for 3 months after starting work.

CASE STUDY

Azzedine's Beam story

<u>Azzedine</u> was about to be evicted with nowhere to go when he found his home of 12 years was being illegally sublet.

Beam helped him:

- **Train** as a security guard
- > **Pay** for laptop, clothes and travel
- → Work full-time at a Beam employer partner



CASE STUDY

David's Beam story

David was forced to leave his family and was diagnosed with mouth cancer within a few weeks of each other, and couldn't afford to rent a new place.

Beam helped him:

- → **Find** a suitable property
- → Liaise with landlords
- Pay for his deposit, first month's rent & household essentials.

Referrals take two minutes:


- 1. Go to **beam.org/refer**
